Hadith Reminder

Ibn Abbas narrated, that the Messenger of Allah (PBUH) said:

"There is no deed more precious in the sight of Allah, nor greater in reward, than a good deed done during the ten days of Sacrifice." He was asked, "Not even jihad for the sake of Allah?" He said, "Not even jihad for the sake of Allah, except in the case of a man who went out to fight giving himself and his wealth up for the cause, and came back with nothing."

(Sahih al-Bukhari 969)

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What to do in the first 10 days of Dhul Hijjah

- Fasting - It is Sunnah to fast on the first nine days of Dhul-Hijjah
- Takbir - It is Sunnah to say Takbir, Tahmid, Tahlil and Tasbih during the first ten days of Dhul-Hijjah
- Sacrifice - highly encourage Sunnah
- Doing more good deeds in general

Hadith Reminder

Sahl Ibn Sa'ad narrated, that the Messenger of Allah (PBUH) said:

“Fasting the day of ‘Arafah I hope Allah will expiate thereby for the year before it and the year after it, and fasting the day of ‘Ashoora’ I hope Allah will expiate thereby for the year that came before it.”

(Sahih al-Bukhari 1957)

Ibn Abbas narrated:

“I never saw the Prophet (PBUH) so keen to make sure he fasted any day and preferring it over another except this day, the day of ‘Ashoora’, and this month – meaning Ramadan.”

(Sahih al-Bukhari 1867)
